What is your advice to those beginning the AGP?

What really helped me, especially at the start, was speaking regularly to both my buddy and my coach. Your buddy helps you to get used to the internal process and introduces you to your new colleagues, while your coach helps you to work on the most exciting projects. Keeping in regular contact with others who are on the AGP also helps, as they have already worked in the various different areas of the business and have thus been able to build up a broad network within the company. They can help you learn more about ongoing projects and what you can expect from your time in the various business units.

What do you expect to gain from this programme?

I think I will be able to benefit from the AGP in three ways. First, the regular rotations will give me the opportunity to gain experience in a number of different areas of the company and thus explore a range of very different subjects – the learning curve over the course of the two years will therefore certainly be a steep one.
