## *Bruna talks*

### *... about her training opportunities*

It takes three to four years to train as a chartered accountant. Exactly how long depends on your highest degree (bachelor or master). Throughout the course, PwC gives us the necessary time off to attend lessons, without loss of salary. Furthermore PwC sponsors each trainee for the costs of the training and examinations. The debt is written off against the next two years' work after passing the module exams.

It's not a coincidence that the first year of training follows on from the end of the first busy season: perfect timing to link theory

and practice. My first year's training came in really useful for my second busy season. We also share knowledge with our colleagues who have been on different courses and gained different experiences.

Training content varies widely. All tutors are recognized practitioners. Lessons are based on auditing practice and on other financial and accounting disciplines.
